"Grace to you and Peace from God our Father and our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ"

I'm sure the above words, a statement really, are very familiar to you. I begin each sermon with these, or similar words. Have you ever wondered where it comes from? Well, the quick answer is Apostle Paul. All of Paul's letters contain two elements, which he avows to the benefit of the letter's recipients. One is "grace," and the other "peace". To the recipients of three of his letters, Paul adds "mercy". But in all his letters, "grace" appears to be the foundational element.

We hear this word "grace" often. How would you describe "grace"?

For Martin Luther, to have a God of grace means to believe and trust that through Jesus Christ, God has already met all prerequisites and fulfilled all reciprocations.

In Christian theology, grace is described as: the spontaneous, unmerited gift of the divine favor in the salvation of sinners, and the divine influence operating in individuals for their regeneration and sanctification.

For me, Grace means forgiveness, and without this gift of grace we would be lost forever.

As it relates to Scripture, "grace" is defined in multiple ways:

2 Peter 1 ~ describes how grace is God's unmerited favor toward man

"Grace and peace be yours in abundance through the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord. His divine power has given us everything we need for a godly life through our knowledge of Him who called us by His own glory and goodness"

Ephesians 2: 8-9 ~ describes how God's grace saves us.

"For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast."

Romans 3:24 ~ describes how God's grace justifies us:

"Being justified as a gift by His grace through the redemption which is in Christ Jesus."

2 Thessalonians 2:13 ~ describes how God's grace sanctifies us:

"because God has chosen you from the beginning for salvation through sanctification by the Spirit and faith in the truth."

1 Corinthians 15:10 ~ God's grace also empowers us to service. God wants us to be so full of His grace in our lives that we can say with Paul:

"But by the grace of God I am what I am, and His grace toward me did not prove vain; but I labored even more than all of them, yet not I, but the grace of God with me"

It is through grace that God works effective change in our hearts and lives. Through God's grace we are forgiven, and our thinking is transformed resulting in the renewal of our mind and heart. Through grace we live the kind of life that God would like every one of His children to experience. The grace of God is more than salvation but also everything we need for life and godliness. The good definition of grace could be "God's life, power and righteousness given to us by unmerited favor."

Please join me in prayer ~

Lord, thank you for your abundant, abounding grace. Thank you that we don't have to earn a drop of the mighty river of grace that flows freely for us today. Thank you for the unexpected, unmerited favor you've showered on my life. Help me put myself in the path of your love and grace. Help me not neglect the disciplines I need to meet with you regularly and to drink from the water of life. Thank you for your rich love. Amen.
